High Power Shoots

We have come to the end of another very successful High Power Rifle shooting season and the Chicopee Sportsmen's Club has once again had an outstanding year. Our team has won the Northeast High Power Service Rifle Trophy, the Northeast High Power Match Rifle Trophy, the 1903 Springfield Rifle High Power Rifle Trophy but we lost the Garand Rifle Trophy to Hopkinton. Team members did a lot of traveling up and down the east coast again this year attending matches in Florida, the Creedmoor Matches in North Carolina, the CMP Games in Vermont and the Nationals at Camp Perry Ohio. We took home many trophies, plaques and medals again this year.

Matches shot include the Presidents 100, National Trophy Infantry Team Match, M16 Excellence in Competition Match, Hearst Doubles, M1 Carbine Match the M1A/M14 Rifle Match, the Vintage Sniper Match, 03 Springfield Match, and the Garand Match, and 22 Rifle Matches just to mention a few of them. I want to thank all team members who helped make this year another outstanding one. We are all looking forward to next year and hope to have another productive year. As usual we are always looking for new shooters. One of the major changes to the rules which govern service rifles is that we are now able to use scopes on our rifles which have worked out great for us old guys who can't see a front sight any more. We can now see both the targets and cross hairs. So if you have trouble with iron sights you can now use a scope. (So) if you were not shooting in our matches because you could not see the target or front sights you can now mount a scope on your rifle and have no excuse anymore. Scopes do have a limit of powers which is 1 to 4 power. If you have any questions please contact me and I will be glad to help you sort things out. Look for our 2018 schedule which will be published in March and posted on our website and bulletin boards. We start shooting sometime in April. Thanks again to all. ATV's

All ATV's must have a current registration from the state of Massachusetts and must be registered with the club yearly, with a cost of \$10.00 per machine. If you don't have the current year's sticker you will not be allowed to ride on the club grounds. (Any member caught bringing a non-member to ride a non-registered ATV will be summoned to the Board of Directors for disciplinary action and may face (expulsion from the club). Stickers must be attached to the rear of the ATV in a location that can be seen. Stickers can only be obtained at monthly meetings or at the club, see the 1st V.P., 2nd V.P. or Mike Zybur. No stickers will be issued through the mail. Please stay on club grounds at all times, and do not ride in posted sections. The EPO has been notified of the problem. There is a \$125.00 fine and they can take your ATV. You are off the club property at the powerlines. Follow the rules please and be safe.

Safety Committee

This is a mandatory class to obtain a range pass: No Pre-Registration Required. **October 2017 thru March 2017 the 3rd Thursday of the month at 6:15pm** at the **American Legion Post 266, 74 Pleasant St. Granby, MA 01033** (behind CVS) **April to September 2018 the 3rd Sunday at 10:00am** are at the Chicopee Sportsmen's Clubhouse. You must have a range pass to use any firearm or archery range. The new **range pass** will have to be visible on your person when shooting. Range Safety Officers will be checking membership cards & range passes, please be cooperative, we all want a safe club. Use common sense and courtesy. Please clean up after shooting.
