Auto Text Message, Very Important to be Up Dated on Club Events, Cancellations & Club Meeting Changes

The Chicopee Sportsmen's Club **strongly recommends** that all members' sign up for this text messaging system in addition to our regular forms of communications to notify members about events and other important information related to the club. The content of the text will consist of things like special events, range closures, shooting events, club meetings and other types of club activities. The club recently had to move to a new location for our club meetings and there was no way to notify all club members at such short notice. If you had the text messaging service you would have been notified. We are providing this service in an effort to help you make the most out of our club membership. We hope that everyone with text capability will sign up. Since this is a free service for the club, you will see an advertisement at the bottom of the message. You are under no obligation to explore the website but are welcome to check out the services offered if it is something of interest to you, if not interested just ignore it. Please refer to the website of this service in order to find out more about what is offered at www.rainedout.com. Their service promises there will be no spam and they do not give out phone numbers to any other services or vendors. To sign up for this great service you must first enter this number **84483** as a contact in your phone. In your contacts you will have to give the text number a name examples (Csc text, Auto Text or Csc auto text) whatever is easiest for you. Then go to send text, find the contact (whatever you gave for a name) and type in **CSC2015** in the message box and hit send. If it was done correctly you will receive a confirmation that you are signed up for auto text. It's that easy! If at a later date you wish to discontinue the service you can easily remove your number from the list by visiting the company's website www.rainedout.com and click on unsubscribe at the bottom of the page. This is a free service and does not cost the club anything. You will receive all updates. Positions not filled in November will stay open until the December meeting. **Voting:** To be eligible to vote at the December meeting you must show a **2016 membership card** and be a member for a **minimum of one year**.

ATV's

All ATV's must have a current registration from the state of Massachusetts. All ATV's must register with the club each year with a cost of \$10.00 per machine. If you don't have the current year's sticker you will not be allowed to ride on the club grounds. Any member caught bringing a nonmember to ride a non-registered ATV will be summoned to the Board of Directors for disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from the club. Stickers must be attached to the rear of the ATV in a location that can be seen. Stickers can only be obtained at monthly meetings or at the club, see the 1st V.P. or 2nd V.P. or Mike Zybura. No stickers will be issued through the mail. Please stay on club grounds at all times, and do not ride on posted sections. The EPO has been notified of the problem. There is a \$125.00 fine and they can take your ATV. You are off the club property at the powerlines. Follow the rules please and be safe.

Safety Committee

There is a mandatory class to obtain a range pass: No Pre-Registration Required. **October 2016 thru March 2017 the 3rd Thursday of the month at 6:15pm at the American Legion Post 266, 74 Pleasant St. Granby, MA 01033 (behind CVS) April to September 2017 the 3rd Sunday at 10:00am** are at the Chicopee Sportsmen's Clubhouse. You must have a range pass to use any firearm or archery range. The new range pass will have to be visible on your person when shooting. Range Safety Officers will be checking membership cards & range passes, please be cooperative, we all want a safe club. Use common sense and courtesy. Please clean up after shooting.
