CAMPING RULES

Camping Definition: Overnight Occupancy in Camper or Tent

1. Must be a club member to reserve campsites.
2. Must call Camp Director for reservations – (413) 386-1745.
Give your Name, Badge Number, Camper Registration and Telephone Number.
3. If you have to cancel, notify Camp Director as soon as possible.
4. Campers must follow all Club Rules, Regulations and Policies
5. Rakes and shovels are in the camp shed (site #3) if needed. Please return them back to the shed when finished.
6. All campers will use *Sani-Cans* – do **NOT** use the woods.
7. Please remove all trash from site when you leave. Keep campsite clean for the next user.
8. Bring your own firewood or collect dead wood from wooded areas. No cutting of live trees or bushes allowed.
9. Campers are allowed to stay up to two weeks at the same campsite – extended time must be approved and determined by the Camp Director.
10. No glass in fire pits. Keep fires small and extinguish when you leave the area. Clean fire pit the last day of your stay.
11. No discharge of firearms, air guns or archery (arrows) in camping area.
12. Pets must be leashed and waste cleaned up immediately.
13. Guests may visit during the day; however, they cannot fish, shoot or use the archery range. No overnight guests allowed.
14. No camping during the fall pheasant season.
15. If a member requests a site, said member must stay overnight for a minimum of two nights in a seven day period.
16. Any problems shall be resolved by the Camp Director, Officer, or Camping Committee person.
17. You may use picnic tables during the day if campsite is vacant.
18. Do not take firewood or items from other campsites without permission.
19. Quiet time is from 10:00 pm until 7:00 am. No loud generators or noise.
20. All Campers/RV's must have current DMV registration.
21. If campers bring ATVs, they must adhere to the Club's policies regarding the use of ATV's.
22. Fireworks of any kind are not permitted.
