Club Membership card must be displayed at all times while on club grounds.
New members must attend a range safety class before using any range.
A Range Pass will be issued to a club member age 15 or older after completing a class and passing a five question test.
Range Pass must be displayed at all times while using any firearm or archery range.

In addition to the revised Range Safety Rules and in the interest of safety training and mentoring, the following protocols will apply to young shooters:

Long Guns (Rifles/Shotguns):

Minimum age to shoot: 8 years.

Caliber/Gauge restrictions

8 to 12 years old: 22 Rim Fire/410 Gauge only. Must be under the direct supervision of a properly licensed (FID or LTC) parent or legal guardian. Only one gun between them allowed at the shooting position.

13 to 14 years old: May shoot larger caliber rifles and larger gauge shotguns, but must also be under the direct supervision of a properly licensed (FID or LTC) parent or legal guardian with only one gun between them allowed at the shooting position.

15 to 18 years old: may shoot own gun if he/she is properly licensed (FID card) (Hunter Safety) and strictly complies with all Range Safety Rules.

Hand Guns:

Minimum age to shoot: 12 years.

Caliber/Gauge restrictions

12 to 15 years old: Restricted to 22 rim fire only and must be under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian who is properly licensed (Class A or B LTC) with one gun between them allowed at the shooting position.

16 to 20 years old: May fire larger caliber handguns under the direct supervision of a parent or legal guardian who is properly licensed (Class A or B LTC) with only one gun between them allowed at the shooting position.

Full Auto Guns:

Full auto guns may be used only by those who posses proper licenses. No exceptions!

CHICOPEE SPORTSMEN'S CLUB Rules and Regulations

Membership card must be worn at all times when on club grounds.

Gate must be locked at all times except for announced functions. Speed limit is 15MPH unless posted.

No glass containers on club ranges.

Members may bring guest once to the club grounds. **However, guests are not allowed to fish or discharge firearms or arrows.** A member must accompany guest at all times.

Open Water Fishing: One pole with one hook per person; no party fishing, no shiners allowed; daily bag limit three (3) trout. All fish caught must be kept. No catch and release.

Ice Fishing: Dates, hours will be posted. One tip-up or jigger per person; no shiners; limit two fish per person (limit set by board if directors). Fish caught must be registered before leaving club grounds.

Hunting: Daily limit-one pheasant; **Hunter Orange caps and vest required**, all other limits and rules according to club regulations, Mass Hunting License required.

Overnight Camping: By permit only from camp director.

Trapping: By permit only from President or Grounds Chairman.

Removal of trees, bushes, stones, etc. by permit only from President or Grounds Chairman.

Club facilities and membership privileges shall be suspended if dues are not paid by January 1st of each year.

All signs and any reasonable orders from safety personal or club officers are to be followed.

Black Powder Range (Right portion of black powder range): Limited to .22 rim fire, black powder and shotguns. Follow rules posted at range.

Skeet: Skeet can be used to the right of the black powder range only. Please clean up after use

Plinking Range (Left portion of black powder range): Limited to .22 rim fire, air and BB guns only. No center fire. Targets must be elevated so that projectiles impact berm (.22 rim fire firearms may be used on both sides of black powder range).

Pistol Range: Limited to pistol shooting with a caliber of not larger than .44. Larger calibers must be used at the high power range. Follow rules posted at range.

Rifle Range: Primarily for rifle shooting. Pistol, black powder, shotguns and air rifles can also be used. Follow rules posted at range.

Follow specific rules posted at all ranges.
